
To begin the application process for TAMS:

Create an account on the <u>Apply Texas website</u>. You will need an email address and a password that is at least 14 characters. **Do NOT use** your high school email address as you will not be able to log back into the Apply Texas portal if you lose access to your high school email account.

Step 1:

Find the right application. Select "Yes" for the High School/Middle School question and select "Undergraduate Program" even if you have completed Dual Credit hours anywhere. If you select Dual Credit, you will not be presented with selecting TAMS on the "Select School and Apply" page.

Complete the Core Questions

You can save your profile as you move through each page. You may need parental input for some of the sections (Household, Residency, Emergency Contact, etc.). Please be thorough in this section, it is the longest section so please take your time.

Here are notes on some things to be careful of as you complete this section.

READ THE QUESTIONS AND READ THE INSTRUCTIONS! Read them again. Did it ask for country or country? Today's date or your date of birth? Don't just race through the application assuming you know what to put in each blank. Read the question and answer the question that is asked.

You need to use a personal email address that you can access easily because ApplyTexas will randomly decide that it needs verification/authentication and send a code to your email for you to enter.

You may be given the option to Enroll in ADVi – the virtual advisor. **Do not sign up** or agree to use this service. The information in this system is not relevant to TAMS applicants.

1. About you

- a. Be sure you check the confirmation/verification box after you have checked to see that the information you entered is correct.
- b. Permanent address, residential address, and mailing address these are usually the same, but this can vary based on individual circumstances.
- c. Be sure the email address you indicate is one you can access easily and CHECK IT OFTEN.
- d. Application Representative Would you like to designate someone besides yourself to be able to discuss your file with the target univeristy's admissions office? You can put a parent or guardian, but because you are a TAMS student and a minor, we will be able to discuss your application with your parent or guardian whether or not you list them here.
- e. Date and place of birth double check for accuracy and check the confirmation that the information is correct.
- f. Gender, race and ethnicity This information will NOT be used to determine admission, but we do use it for statistics after a student attends TAMS. We also need to know gender to make residence hall room assignments.
- g. Citizenship Information please be careful and double check accuracy of your answers.
- h. Military status, foster care
- i. Language please answer this question but you may be asked again on another form if English is your first language.
