- f. Gender, race and ethnicity – This information will NOT be used to determine admission, but we do use it for statistics after a student attends TAMS. We also need to know gender to make residence hall room assignments.
- g. Citizenship Information – please be careful and double check accuracy of your answers.
- h. Military status, foster care
- i. Language – please answer this question but you may be asked again on another form if English is your first language.

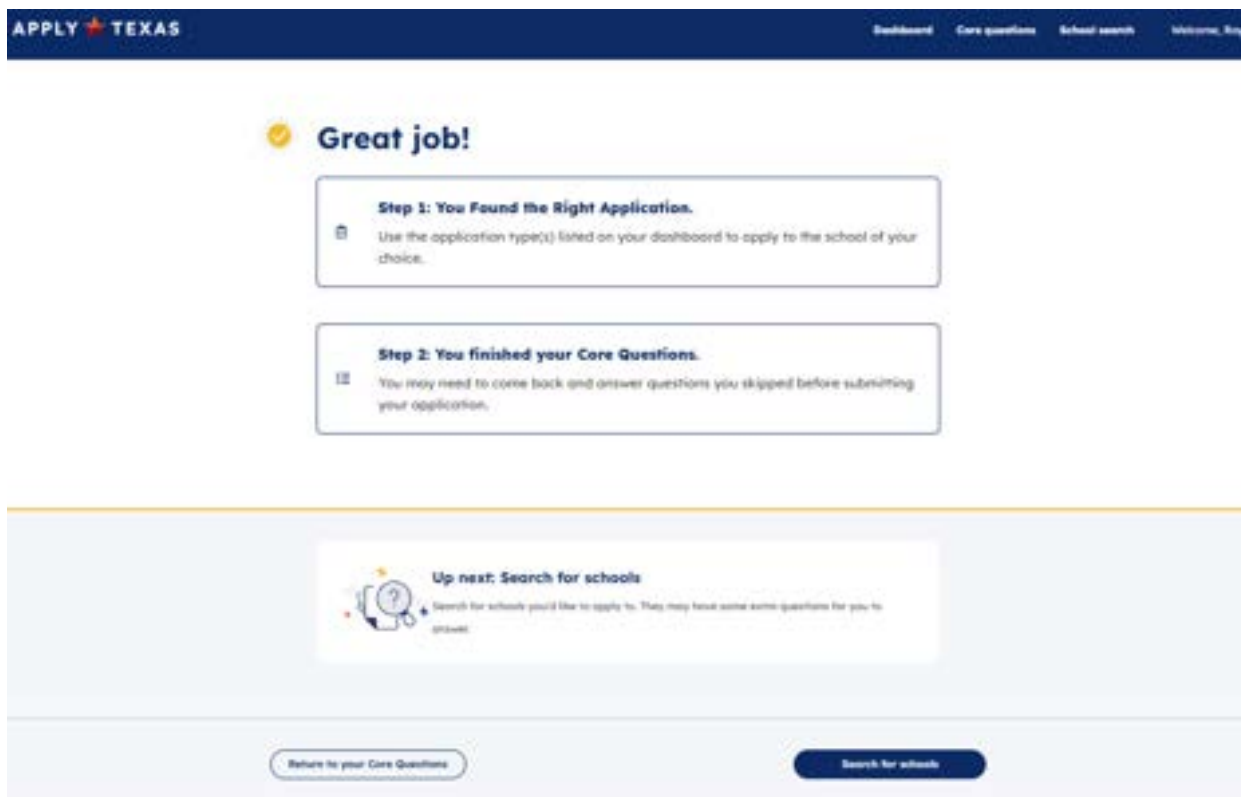

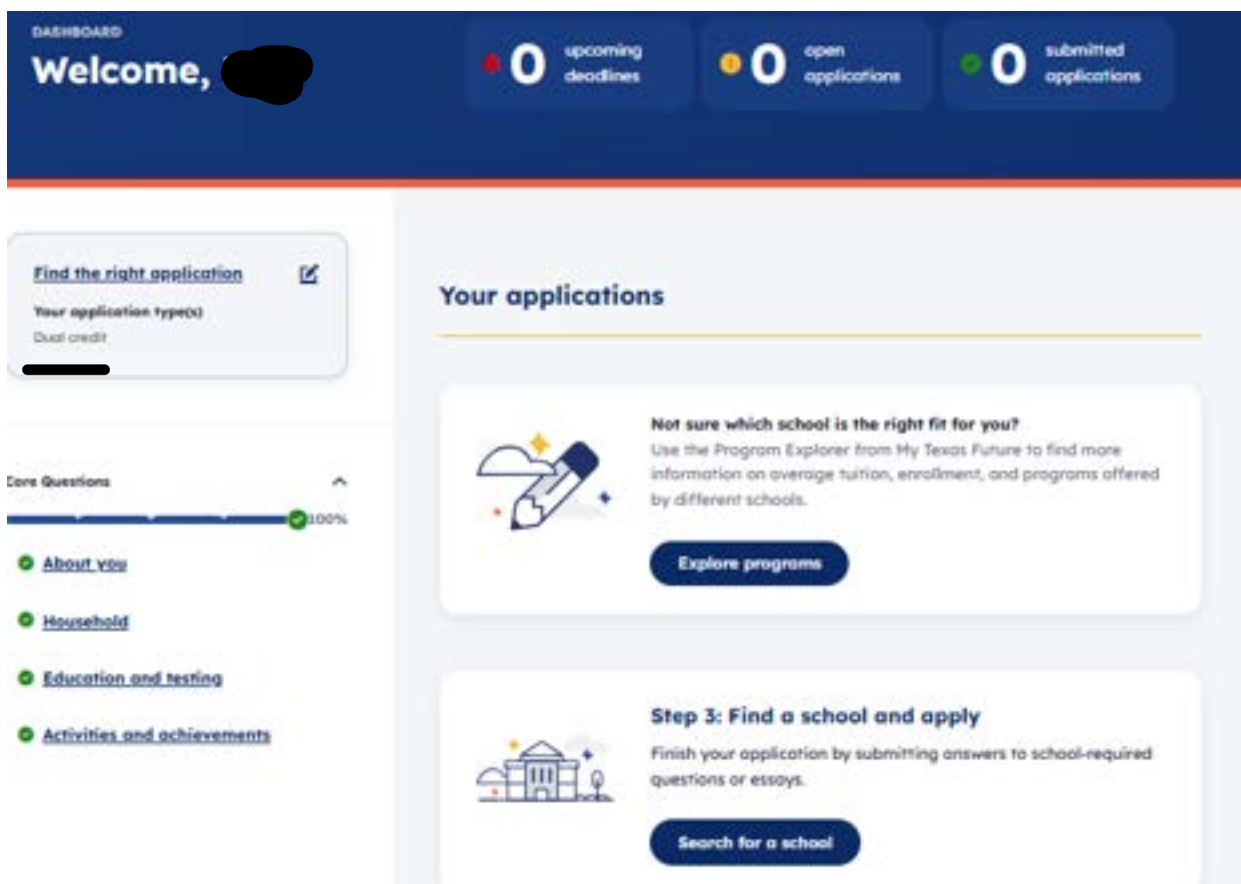
