


Borrowing


Online Holds

- Processed within 48 hours if available
- Email notification when ready, pickup within 7 days

- Includes books, articles, chapter of books, videos, CD's
- Loan period varies, Limit of 4 items, No renewals







Interlibrary Loan


INTERLIBRARY LOAN

- Accessing items not available through UNT
- Interlibrary Loan (ILL) allows borrowing materials from other libraries
- Available to UNT faculty, staff, students, and retired faculty
- Picked up different locations or accessed electronically

Materials not available through ILL

- Textbooks
- Sound recordings
- DVD's and videos faculty only


